Coop Kyosai started providing mutual aid (life and fire insurance) under the Kokumin Kyosai co-op system.

25 million Signature Petition Campaign



Resulting in:

- The 1998 Act on Support for Reconstructing the Livelihoods of Disaster Victims
- Payment of 3.87 billion dollars to earthquake victims to date

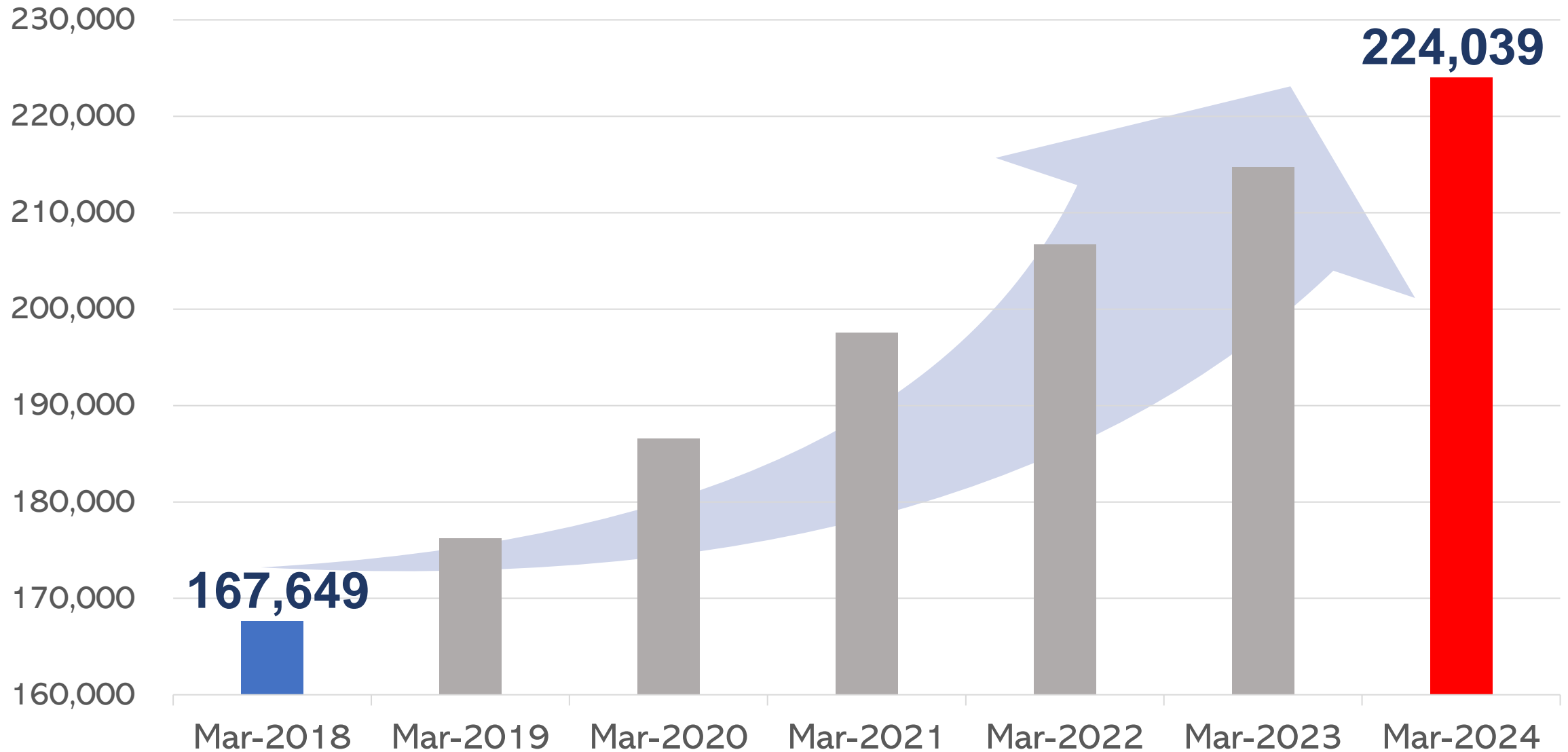
**The Co-creation council
